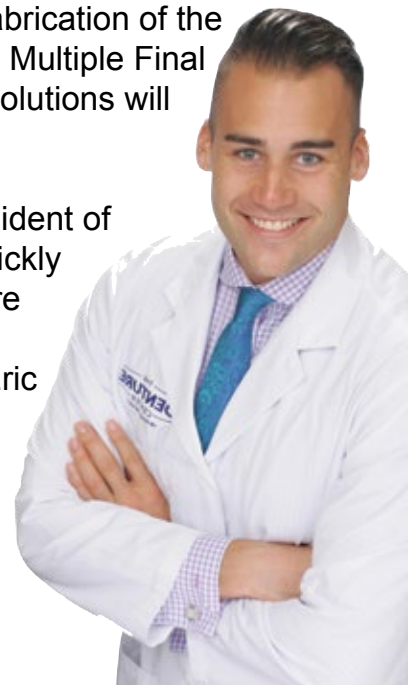

Nobel Biocare - All On Teeth Solutions
Speaker: Eric D. Kukucka, DD

Outline: This presentation will discuss various aspects of full arch rehabilitation for both the terminal dentition patient and the edentulous patient with the all on teeth solution. Multiple case presentations will be overviewed. Case selection (treatment planning diagnostics with CBCT diagnostic in conjunction with Nobel clinician as well as proper clinic photographs). Various implants and their connections (internal, external which is better and why?); multiunit abutments and how they work; abutment level impression techniques; and a start-to-finish, step-by-step all on 4 teeth in a day conversion, from initial denture tooth set up to the immediate provisionalisation to the fabrication of the final definitive prosthesis. Multiple Final definitive final prosthetic solutions will also be presented.

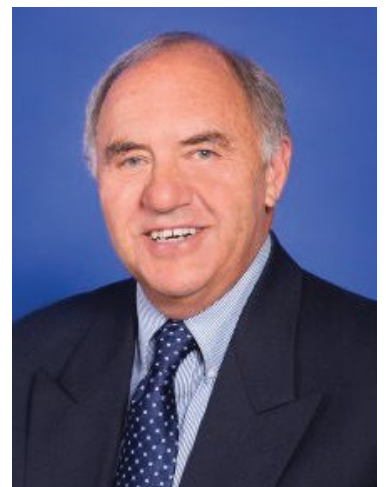

with Kulzer**

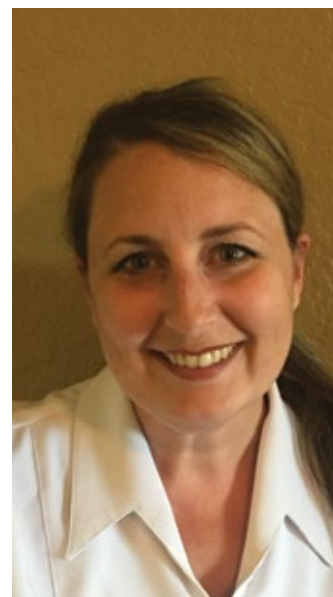
Speaker: Jennifer Gordon, DD

Outline: This session is an introduction to both of Kulzer's digital denture systems. We will overview the Pala digital denture system where a denture can be fitted and delivered in as little as two appointments and processed by Kulzer; and the Private Label solution, where a digital denture is made in a more traditional fashion and processed within the Denturist's own lab.

Bio: Jennifer graduated from GBC in 2008 and has continued to

pursue new technology and techniques in order to make fitting dentures a more precise and streamlined system. In July of 2016, she traveled to South Bend, IN to spend time at Kulzer's head office, training in their two digital denture techniques. This included scanning requirements for both model and bite blocks

and an impression technique with a built in Gothic arch tracing, prototype and wax try ins and how to do adjustments and lab finish a case. These techniques have been integrated into Jennifer's practice in the Niagara region resulting in fewer appointments, fewer adjustments and overall happier patients!

Speaker: Dean Fenwick

Outline: This course goes over less known but useful features in DOMx and ensures everyone has a full understanding of the recall features to ensure your business thrives and all patients get the care they need.

WHMIS – Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System 2015

Outline: This course has been customized for people who provide denture/dental services, highlighting products they use on a regular basis. We will discuss the health and safety hazards of these products along with ways the manufacturers recommend that workers be protected. Testing is mandatory under law, and a test will be conducted at the end of the program which complies with the legislation. Each participant will receive course material and a certificate of participation recognizing that they are trained as per the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

Perspectives on Denture Occlusion; It's More Than Slapping Teeth Together
Speaker: Marc Wagenseil DD, CDT, VITA Global Trainer

Outline: Denturists are proficient in making dentures for patients. In fact, it is routine to produce several types of removable dentures and the outcome for the patient is most often successful but sometimes it is not. Why? Why do anterior teeth chip or pop-off, sores develop, patients communicate that they can't chew properly, or new dentures crack? Complications can especially be more so for implant retained dentures. Explore a fresh perspective on

occlusion and denture integration for the patient. Themes to be discussed are the costs of adjustments, freedom in centric, deflective contacts, natural chewing cycle, anterior overjet, sensitivity, and more. With a new understanding of biological and biomechanical principles in setting teeth you will learn how to minimize deflective contacts. Learning to use these techniques will consistently cut your adjustment rate in half and help eliminate post-delivery patient issues. Join Marc to renew your passion for dentures and rise above complacency. It truly is more than slapping teeth together.

Bio: Marc is a VITA Certified Global Trainer and in 2017 he celebrated 30 years in the dental industry working directly with patients and uniquely in the dental lab. He owns Heritage Denture Centre and Heritage Dental Lab in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada. Having trained extensively in Germany on theories, systems, and occlusion



concepts related to dentures and implant supported dentures, Marc has lectured and provided hands-on education internationally to dentists, denturists and dental technicians on occlusion, dentures and implant supported dentures. Bio: Dr. Tyler Verhaeghe is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the School of Dentistry at the University of Alberta. He is the lecturer and coordinator for the pre-clinical removable partial denture and complete denture prosthodontics courses in addition to clinical teaching and practice. With a Master in Health Sciences Education, his current research focuses on the use of technology in the education of removable prosthodontics. He co-authored an electronic textbook on complete dentures to the Apple iBooks Store in Fall 2016. He will be returning to school for graduate prosthodontics at UBC starting in Summer 2017. Tyler has lectured in Germany and has been on dental mission trips to Guatemala and Nicaragua.
